**WHAT:** Attorney General Maura Healey will meet with a group of North Quincy High School and Quincy High School students and teachers to discuss their involvement with [Game Change: The Patriots Anti-Violence Partnership](#)

The first phase of the Game Change program will train 196 school personnel at six regional trainings across Massachusetts. The trainings will be conducted by Mentors in Violence Prevention (MVP), a nationwide leader in addressing violence prevention. Students will also be trained to become peer leaders who can teach younger students about healthy relationships and bystander intervention.

Regional trainings begin Monday, Jan. 11 at UMass Dartmouth, with five more to follow across the state. Quincy personnel will be participating in a training for the South Shore schools at a later date.
